ICONOGRAPHY WORKSHOP AT STAR OF THE SEA

Star of the Sea is pleased to announce a very special class in Iconography painting this summer. We will be hosting an Iconography Workshop here August 14 to August 19. The instructor will be Iconographer Raymond Vincent from Holy Theophany Romanian Greek Catholic Monastery in Olympia, WA. Raymond comes from a fine-arts background and has focused principally on Byzantine Iconography since 2008. He works to foster and popularize the iconographic tradition by offering workshops to the public. DETAILS: Class size is limited to a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 18 students. The workshop will run at least 4 1/2 days; an evening introductory session followed by four full work days from 9 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., with a one hour lunch break, and continuing from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. All supplies and materials are provided as well as a catered lunch each day. COST: \$400.00. We will need a non-refundable security deposit of \$75.00 per student by July 13 to cover reparation and travel expenses for Raymond.
