THE WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

Observed on Sunday, April 22nd, also known as “Good Shepherd Sunday”. The purpose of this day is to publicly fulfill the Lord’s instruction to “Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest” (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). Let us pray that young men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord’s call to the priesthood, the diaconate and the religious life:
